The only exception to this is group-related merchandise (like an official group t-shirt, etc.) that may be posted by an administrator from time to time.
- 3. Spirited discussions are encouraged, but name-calling is not acceptable. You will be warned, then removed from the group if it becomes a problem.

- Do NOT copy and post another person's photos without their permission.
- Limit your use of shorthand and IM speak we have many international members and this can make it very difficult for some people to understand posts.

HOW TO REPORT A POST

If you need to report something that has been posted in this group, hover your cursor over the top right of the post and click the icon which will appear there.
